

Ambassador Takeshi YAGI was born in Niigata in 1954. He graduated from Tokyo University (Faculty of Law) and entered the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) in 1977. He studied at the University of Munich from 1978 to 1980.



After various posts in the MOFA Headquarters in Tokyo as well as in the Philippines, the United States, Germany and France, he served as Director-General at the Economic Affairs Bureau of MOFA from 2010 to 2012. He was appointed Ambassador to India in 2012. He then served as Ambassador to Germany from 2015 to 2020. During his career he was posted to the Embassy of Japan in Germany four times. He has been elected as the new President of the Japanese-German Center Berlin at the end of March 2023.
