
Countries where most traffic came from




Devices most used to log into the platform









The very comprehensive fair was very helpful and efficient in gathering information! It was especially helpful to be able to consult directly with the person in charge through the chat function. Thank you very much!





It was a very valuable opportunity to learn about the various support systems for research activities in Germany in a single occasion.


4. Exhibitor Feedback – Questionnaire Results³
